What Is It ?

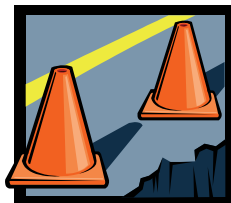
Quality Asphalt Construction is a comprehensive 1 day course covering all aspects of the laydown and compaction operations.

- ⊙ Others needing more in depth knowledge of construction practices

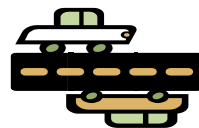


What's In It ?

This class will cover all aspects of placing and compacting quality asphalt pavements.

Chuck Deahl will cover all aspects of rollers and compaction, including discussions on the types of rollers and their use and application, setting up roller patterns, balancing rollers with production and laydown, achieving spec density, impacts on smoothness and new technologies like intelligent compaction and GPS systems

The Instructors

Charles W. (Chuck) Deahl

Chuck Deahl is the National Accounts Manager for Bomag Americas, Inc. representing the Hypac and Bomag compaction lines. He has been in the construction equipment and asphalt technology business since 1965. He is on of the best known and most sought after speakers on compaction in the nation and has traveled and presented paving seminars in the USA, Europe and Russia. For many years he has participated in the NAPA Paving Superintendent’s seminars and has presented seminars to major paving manufacturers, contractors and DOT’s.

T.A. (Tom) Skinner

Tom began his career with Blaw-Knox in 1956 working in the engineering department. In 1960 he joined the service department where he became manager in 1965. Soon after assuming this position he originated the first Blaw-Knox training program for the asphalt paving industry. That program expanded reaching 1500-1800 paving personnel each year up through 2002. Another 200 to 3500 people were reached annually as he spoke for the various asphalt paving associations preaching the “Gospel of Smooth Asphalt Pavements”. Tom retired as Dean of the B-K/I-R Institute and presently does consulting work teaching the art of laying “High Quality Asphalt Pavements. His goal is to achieve the highest quality while maintaining lowest cost per ton.
