What Is It ?

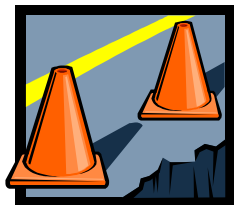
Quality Asphalt Construction is a comprehensive 1 day course covering all aspects of the delivery and compaction operations.

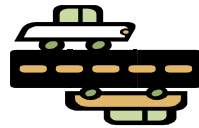
